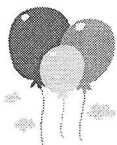

Jane Basher enjoyed an extended visit with her family in Mississippi. Ask Jane to tell you about that precious Great Granddaughter!

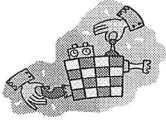
Allen and Nancy Nickel are having a great time taking "shake down" trips with their travel vacation trailer.

Thanks to Shirley Kiley of Melissa Lane, the books in our Rec Hall Library are in order by author and title! Thanks, Shirley!!!

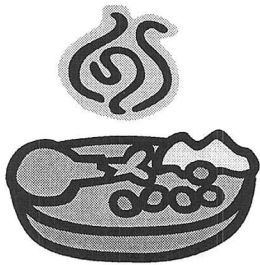
